Presentation

ItchCare™ cream: Each gram cream contains Diphenhydramine Hydrochloride BP 20 mg & Zinc Acetate BP 1 mg.

Description

It contains two active ingredients: Diphenhydramine Hydrochloride & Zinc Acetate. Diphenhydramine works as a topical analgesic and Zinc Acetate works as a skin protectant.

Indications and Uses

Temporarily relieves pain and itching associated with:

- insect bites
- minor burns
- sunburn
- minor skin irritations
- minor cuts
- scrapes

Dosage and Administration

Adults and children from 2 years of age: Apply to affected area 3 to 4 times daily. Children under 2 years of age: As directed by the physician.

Side-effects

No serious side effects were reported. Rash, photosensitivity, local irritation, hypersensitivity reactions may occur.

Precautions

For external use only. Avoid contact with the eyes.

Use in pregnancy & lactation

Pregnancy:

May be used during pregnancy.

Lactation:

May be used while breastfeeding.

Contraindications

Hypersensitivity to any of the ingredients of this formulation.

Drug interactions

No significant interactions known or found for this formulation.

Overdose

No data provided. General supportive measures should be employed.

Storage

Do not store above 30⁰ C. Keep away from light and out of the reach of children.
